## Tuition and Fee Exemptions

The Texas Legislature has provided a tuition and fee exemption, excluding general property deposit and student services fees, provided under 54.204 and 54.205 of the Texas Education Code.

## Exemptions

To obtain the exemption, an approved application must be on file with the Financial Aid Office six weeks before registration. Tuition and fee exemptions are granted for the following categories of students:

- Blind/Deaf Student Exemption Program
- Educational Aide Exemption
- Children of Disabled or Deceased Firemen
- Peace Officers, Game Wardens and Employees of Correctional Institutions
- Children of U.S. Military who are Missing in Action or Prisoners of War (MIA/POWs)
- Concurrent Enrollment Waiver
- Early High School Graduation Scholarship
- Exemption for Dual-Enrolled Students
- Exemption for Highest Ranking High School Graduate
- Exemption for Peace Officers Disabled in the Line of Duty
- Exemption Program for Clinical Perceptors and their Children
- Exemption Program for Children of Professional Nursing Program Faculty and Staff
- Exemptions for Texas Veterans; Orphans of Texas Members of the U.S. Armed Forces or National Guard
- Senior Citizen, 55 or Older, Tuition Reduction Program
- Senior Citizen, 65 or Older, Free Tuition for 6 credit hours
- Students in Foster or other Residential Care
- TANF Exemption Program
- Texas National Guard Tuition Assistance Program
- Adopted Student Formerly in Foster and Residential Care

## Emergency Loans

The Emergency Loan process is now online for your convenience and can be located at Scorpion Online

In order to qualify for an emergency loan, students must meet the following requirements:

1. be registered for current semester
2. not be in default of a federal or institutional student loan
3. not have any outstanding debt to the university and
4. have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 and a minimum completion rate of 70 percent or higher

If you are a first, time freshman, the GPA and completion rate requirements will not apply for the first semester of attendance.

## Application Timeline

### May

Half of the tuition and fees are required for the emergency loan for the May session.

Application: May 12, 2009

Emergency loan payment deadline for May session: June 18, 2009

### Summer I

Early registration: May 28-29

Late registration: June 8-9

Emergency loan payment deadline for summer I: July 8, 2009

### Summer II

Early registration: July 2-July 3

Late registration: July 14-July 15

Emergency loan payment deadline for summer II: August 14, 2009
